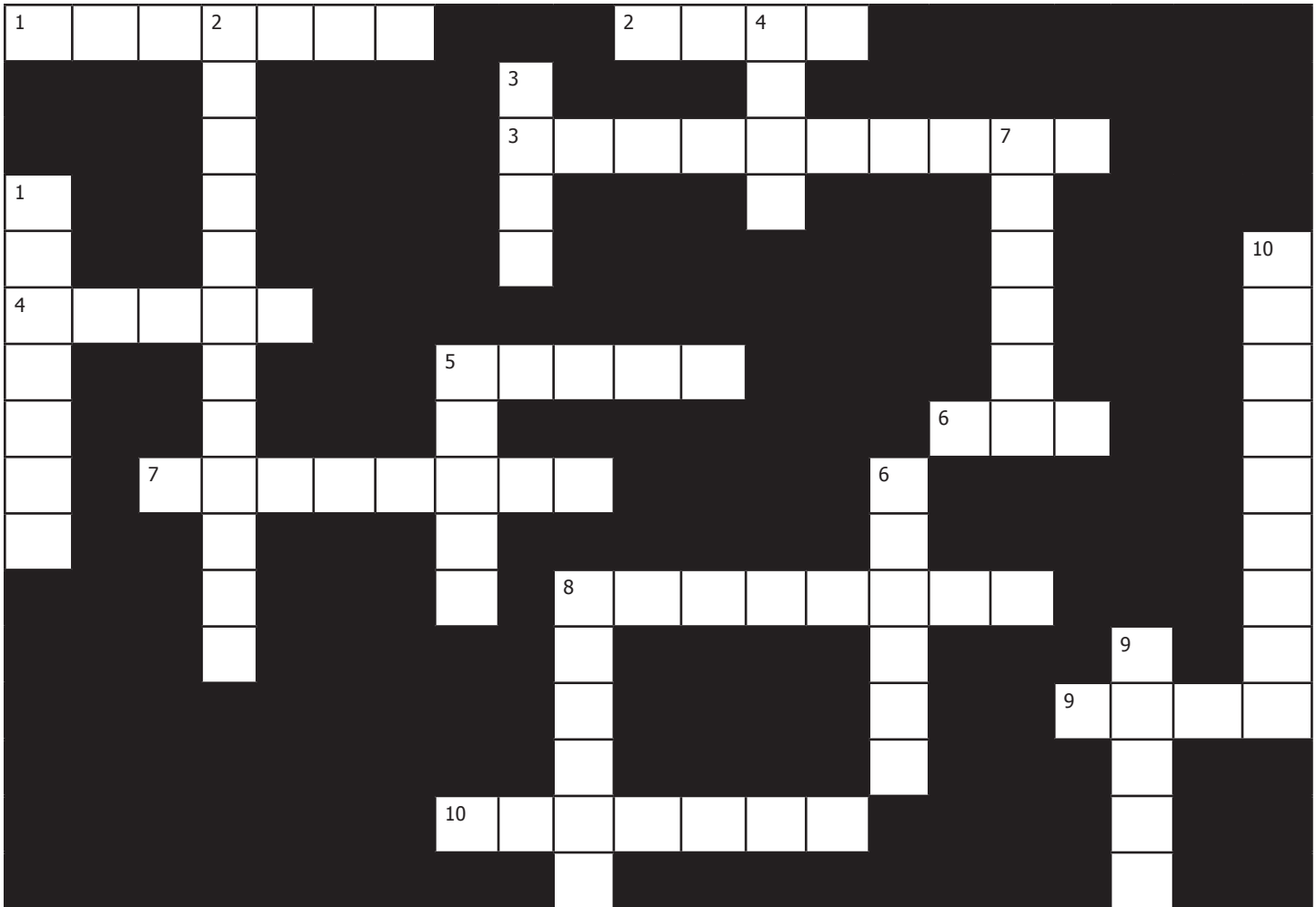


# Teen Driving Crossword Puzzle
